John Stevens of Kent, otherwise called John Stevens of St. Mary's Co. Planter
July 6, 1683

Amount owed 2500 lbs. tob. Was to be paid Nov. 10, 1677. 6,000 lbs. tob. in
~~xxxx~~ damages requested. Deft claims debt is paid. Trial by jury ordered.
The jury found that the debt was not fully satisfied but that 1400 lbs. remained
to be paid. In final hearing deft defaulted. Plts awarded 1400 lbs. and 1000
lbs. costs of suit.

Allowed to Henry Smith of St. Maries Co. for coming going to testify for John
Stevens 16 days in all 30 lbs. tob. per day - 400 lbs.
Same for Robert Mason.
