## SUDDEN ILLNESS AND DEATH OF MRS. HILL

Conway, June 6.—Special. The entire town was cast in deep gloom last evening by the sudden illness and death of Mrs. Fannie Askins Hill, wife of the Rev. D. L. Hill, pastor of the Conway Baptist Church. Mrs. Hill was stricken with acute gastritis Monday morning and died Tuesday evening at 9 o'clock, in the forty-third year of her age. She was a woman of rare worth, a loving and devoted wife and mother, and a noble Christian character. She was one of the mainstays of the Conway Baptist Church, in which she was a sincere and earnest worker.

She is survived by her husband and four children besides two brothers, S. E. Askins, of Hartsville; A. H. Askins, of Timmons ville, and a sister, Mrs. Crowwell, of Hartsville.

Her remains were interred in the Sardis Baptist Church cemetery, near Timmons ville, Thursday morning, where they were taken Wednesday afternoon. The funeral services were conducted by the local pastor, assisted by the Rev. E. L. McCoy, of Conway. Those who accompanied the body from Conway were J. C. Spivey, C. H. Snider and G. B. Jenkins.
